We offer most products in different wood species, with pleasure we also give advice.

We will send you an Pro Forma according to your inquiry.

With your confirmation of the Offer and our acknowledgement, your order will be obligatory and will be carried out accordingly.

Before shipment we will e-mail you pictures of your products.

Minimum Order Quantity:

Basically we are not bounded to a Minimum Order Quantity.

We can ship goods in collective container to Hamburg/Germany therefore we are able to accept also smaller orders (with a total minimum value of 1000Euro) from Customers in Germany or neighbour countries.

Orders from different countries will have to be delivered in a 20ft Container. (Airfreight is possible, but depending on the product quite expensive.)

Conditions of Payment:

For small Orders from Germany and neighbour countries:

50% advance payment by confirmation of order by transfer to our German bank account. Remaining payment by arrival of goods in Hamburg.

On container purchase / Orders from other countries or depending on the total order value:

Payment through Letter of Credit or advance payment to our Ghana bank account possible.

Transport, -costs, -companies:

The transport cost of a 20ft Container from Takoradi/Ghana to Hamburg/Germany is depending on the shipping company (e.g. Maersk, Delmas, Grimaldi) between 800 and 1200 Euro.

We mainly ship with the shipping line Delmas and mainly deal with the transport company Kuehne&Nagel for the transport from Hamburg to the Customer.

With pleasure we also organize the shipping for you to any other destination, the transport costs will be added to the offer.

Prices:

All shown prices are FOB-Prices, that means that they are Free on Board at harbor Takoradi/Ghana and do not include transportation cost from Takoradi/Ghana to the consignee.

For Products shipped in a Collective Container to Germany: Tax (VAT - MwSt) has to be added.

Packaging:

The products of an order are packed according to their nature and volume in boxes made from plywood or massive wood on pallets. This packaging is included in the FOB-price.

For very heavy goods the box is constructed in that way that the frame of the box can be removed, so that it is easy to unpack the product.

Quality Control - damaged goods

EcoCraft's products are undertaken by a strict quality control before shipment. In case still the products would arrive damaged, we kindly ask you to contact us immediately.

Production capacity:

Our production capacity depends on the order volume and order situation.

Our production time is due to the careful wood drying process at least 3 Months.

Due to the different nature of our product groups, a specific offer can only be made on an specific inquiry (quantity).

Product Label:

EcoCraft can supply you with labels for the products (see sample on next page).

Because of the temperature variation during the transport we can not apply the label to the product before shipment, they will be posted separate.

All products will have the EcoCraft logo burned on them (small).

EcoCraft Raw Material:

EcoCraft products are made to 90% from “waste wood” (wood not otherwise utilized) and 10% sawn lumber, all of the timber company Samartex (www.samartex.com), whose timber is all sourced from controlled managed natural forests. Selective felling and natural regeneration ensures sustainability of the forests.

Samartex Forests were audited in November 2006 by the Rainforest Alliance ‘Smartwood initiative’ to the FSC Controlled Wood Standard.

Smartwood is the worldwide leading auditor for FSC.

Through a detailed documented and controlled origin of the raw material up to the finished product and the short trade route direct from the producer to special retail shops and markets, the origin of EcoCraft products can be easily traced back.

EcoCraft Wood Species:

African Mahogany (*Khaya ivorensis*)

Weight: 500kg/m³ at 12-14% MC

African Mahogany is found all over West and Central Africa. It ranges in types according to location: from the small *Khaya Senegalensis* in the Sahel down to *Khaya Ivorensis* in the tropical forests. EcoCrafts *Khaya Ivorensis* is ubiquitous in the forest and grows almost any-where. It is one of the world’s famous timbers due to its versatility and excellent working characteristics. In traditional medicine the bark is used to counter high blood pressure and to treat sore stomachs.

African Walnut (*Lovoa Klaineana*)

Weight: 520kg/m³ at 12-14% MC

The 'African Walnut or Lovoa is a relatively scarce tree whose bumpy, fibrous exterior hides a beautiful timber of irregular dark stripes in a gold-brown wood. It is relatively easy to work with and finishes well. Traditional animist belief holds that burning the bark of Lovoa will drive out bad spirits from a house.

Asanfena (*Anigeria spp*)

Weight: 550kg/m³ at 12-15%MC

The Asanfena tree is one of the most valuable timbers in the world. It has a fashionable pale wood. The tree itself likes hilly areas. The fruits of the tree are a much sought-after food for forest animals such as antelopes

Danta (*Nesogordonia papaverifera*)

Weight: 750kg/m³ at 12-15%MC

Danta is with 750 kg/m³ a medium heavy wood. It has the attractive Mahogany red colour. Its very fine grain is promising a high quality finishing.

Denya (*Cylicodiscus gabunensis*)

Weight: 950kg/m³ at 12-15%MC

Denya is a timber of a high natural durability (including resistance against marine borers). It has a distinctive yellowish-red heartwood, which has an amber shine. The Denya bark smells like onions (the bark only!), which is a distinctive characteristic for identifying the tree.

EcoCraft Wood Species:



Ekki / Kaku / Bongossi (*Lophira alata*)

Weight: 1050kg/m³ at 12-15%MC

Ekki is one of Ghana's toughest and most durable commercial species. With a weight of 1050 kg / m³ it is heavier than water. The dark chocolate brown wood is used for heavy structural work, heavy-duty floors, and sea defense. The Ekki tree is form outside similar to the Mahogany tree, but betrays it self with bright red leaves during Christmas time.



Entedua / Etimoe (*Copeifera salikounda*)

Weight: 750kg/m³ at 12-15%MC

A dark reddish-brown wood contains resin with an aromatic substance.



Hyedua (*Guibourtia ehie*)

Weight: 850kg/m³ at 12-15%MC

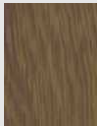
Attractive olive brown dark striped heartwood surrounded by a very pale sapwood.



Kusia / Bilinga (*Nuclea diderrichii*)

Weight: 750kg/m³ at 12-15%MC

The Kusia tree is one of the tallest of the upper storey rainforest trees, sometimes reaching over 30 meters before branching! It grows almost anywhere and is not discouraged by hills or swamps. Traditionally it is used for cooking utensils (i. e. pounding mortar and pestles) due to it's inert and harmless nature. In traditional medicine an infusion of the Kusia bark is often used to treat stomach problems. It has a beautiful golden-yellow wood which gives a pleasing, glowing finish. A naturally high oil content gives durability and superb water resistance.



Kroma (*Klainedoxa gabonesis*)

Weight: 1000kg/m³ at 12-15%MC

Kroma is a heavy duty, durable species for exterior use. Its wood is brown with darker streaks. It is a common large tree with a massive crown.



Niangon (*Heritiera utilis*)

Weight: 625kg/m³ at 12-15%MC

Pink-brown Mahogany colour heartwood. Respected commercial redwood, often used for window frames.



Odum / Iroko (*Milicia excelsa*)

Weight: 650kg/m³ at 12-15%MC

The Odum tree is one of the kings of the forest, reaching gigantic sizes. The impressive nature of the tree sometimes leads to a traditional animist belief that it is the home of forest gods. The wood itself is extremely durable and longlasting. A fallen tree can still be used even after ten years lying in the forest. The wood finishes extremely well with a deep lustre and close grains.



Ofram (Black) (*Terminalia superba*)

Weight: 550kg/m³ at 12-15%MC

The Ofram tree is a relatively fast growing, common tree in Ghana's tropical forest. It quite likes swampy areas, in fact it grows almost anywhere! The wood is a beautiful timber of contrasts, predominantly a pale colour, but with striking black streaks running through it. It almost seems like the lines are created by the tree sucking up the rich, black fertile soil. Traditionally the wood was used for ceilings and construction, as the pronounced long grain gives an impression of space, and the timber is relatively easy to split down to this grain.



Yaya (*Amphimas pterocarpoides*)

Weight: 775kg/m³ at 12-15%MC

Yellowish white heartwood. Superficial resemblance to Oak. Attractive appearance.
